The row numbers indicate the consecutive semester number. The numbers in brackets and in the last column indicate the number of credit points (CP). In each semester, approximately 30 CP should be acquired. The colors have the following meanings:

- red lecture course modules from the major area A to F, at least 23 CP in total
- orange lecture course modules from a minor area A to F, at least 16 CP in total
- yellow lecture course modules from a second minor area A to F, at least 9 CP in total
- green graduate seminars
- grey Master's thesis and Master's thesis seminar (obligatory)
- blue electives, at most 24 CP in total
